
How to access Sakai:

 - Click on the Sakai link located on the bottom of the Northwest State website
 - Click on the Sakai link on the myNSCC login page

- Log in to SAKAI. The login area is in the upper right corner of the page.
 - Your login ID is your N number.
 - Your login password is your birthdate: mmddyy.
