BRIEF HISTORY

1968

The College was founded as Four County Technical Institute.

1969

First classes were offered at the college.

1972

The College moved to its current location and was renamed Northwest Technical College.

1989

The College nearly doubled in size with the completion of the Atrium and the B and C wings.

1994

Northwest State became a community college. This enabled the College to offer associate of arts and associate of science programs.

1997

The Engineering Technology and Science Center was opened.

2002

The Technology Training Center was opened and Custom Training Solutions was developed.

2004

A satellite location was opened in Van Wert, Ohio.

2007

A new lab was built to support the medical assisting program.

2008

A satellite location was opened in Bryan, Ohio. Custom Training Solutions also expanded to include a location on The University of Toledo's Scott Park Campus.

2011

The College opened a new Allied Health & Public Services Building.


2011

NSCC presented degrees to 468 graduates, representing the largest graduating class to date.

2014

A new Advanced Manufacturing Training Center was created to meet workforce development needs.

RECENT HIGHLIGHTS



NSCC students Christine Cox and Kevin Becker were named to the 2014 All-Ohio Academic team, placing them among the top 20 community college students in the state.

NSCC hosted a breast cancer symposium for local health care professionals with support from the Susan G. Komen Northwest Ohio Affiliate.

NSCC received a \$5M grant from the U.S. Dept. of Labor for workforce development training.

TRANSFER OPPORTUNITIES



NSCC is proud to offer *transferable classes and degrees*. To assist students, the College opened the University Center where students can meet **one-on-one with representatives from local colleges and universities**.

Members of the University Center include:



NSCC has implemented a Transfer Assurance Guides (TAG) initiative. Courses that are TAG approved are guaranteed to transfer to any public college or university and apply directly to a student's major. A TAG helps students who have chosen a major enroll in courses that will provide comparable, compatible and equivalent learning experiences across the state's higher education system.

Faculty teams have developed TAG pathways in the **arts, humanities, business, communication, education, health, mathematics, science, engineering technologies and social sciences**.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

NSCC's workforce development programs reach employees in 22 states and six countries. We serve manufacturing, healthcare, education, government, financial services, and other private and public sector organizations.

Custom Training Solutions is a division of NSCC that provides contract training, industrial programs, apprenticeship and manufacturing extension partnership services. For more information, visit TrainwithCTS.com.

NSCC staff coordinates services on behalf of the **Northwest Ohio Manufacturing Extension Partnership**, providing business and technical support to mid-size and small regional manufacturers.

The **Ohio Lean Consortium** provides professional development and networking opportunities, Lean benchmarking tours, and Lean Idea Knowledge Exchange (LIKE) sessions. Lean Six Sigma Yellow and Green Belt trainings and certifications are also offered.

The **Black Swamp Safety Council** is an Ohio Bureau of Workman's Compensation program facilitated by NSCC. The Council provides monthly meetings with health and safety-related educational events, premium discounts on workers compensation insurance, discounts on additional safety training, networking opportunities, and safety best practices.
