The State of Ohio established the "Forever Buckeye" provision in the FY 2012-2013 budget. This provision extends the instate resident tuition rate to any public or private Ohio high school graduate who left Ohio, but returns to enroll an Ohio college and also establishes residency in Ohio by the first day of classes of the requested semester (Revised Code 3333-1-10). The Forever Buckeye provision removes the 12-month period of establishing domicile in Ohio before becoming eligible for in-state tuition rates.
