

NSCC Esports Scholarship Agreement

The following set of rules & expectations **must** be followed by any recipient on an NSCC Thunder Esports team. If recipients are found to be violating **any** of the following rules, **NSCC reserves the right to revoke their scholarship** through recommendation from the acting Esports Coach.

Rules & Expectations

- Recipients must complete and adhere to the “NSCC Esports Lab Keycard Access Agreement”
- Recipients are required to have a current GPA of 2.75 for a full-tuition scholarship or a GPA of 2.5 for a half-tuition scholarship at the time of applying
- Recipients are required to maintain a GPA of 2.5 for a full-tuition scholarship or a GPA of 2.0 for a half-tuition scholarship
- Recipients are required to be a member of at least one NSCC Thunder Esports team roster and, therefore, must complete and adhere to the “NSCC Thunder Team Member Agreement”
- Recipients are required to ensure the NSCC Thunder Esports lab “Thunderdome Rules” are followed by those in the lab at all times; communicating to the acting Esports Coach when any of these rules are broken is expected
- Recipients are required to volunteer during at least 5 Esports events each semester, excl. summer (Game Con is not included in this number, while the 2 days for the team are)
- Recipients are expected to assist in the behind-the-scenes operations of the NSCC Thunder Esports team; refer to the back of this agreement for examples
- Recipients are responsible for communicating any issues regarding their ability to meet the requirements of this agreement directly to the acting Esports Coach; any exceptions are up to the sole discretion of the acting Esports Coach

Examples of Scholarship Recipient Assistance

- Editing videos for the NSCC Thunder YouTube Channel
- Creating and scheduling posts for social media
- Designing handouts such as scholarship flyers, Game Con flyers, etc.
- Adjusting layouts, audio, or other settings for streams through OBS
- Brainstorming and implementing ways to improve recruitment of new members
- Helping run events that are short on staff
- Participating in the Game Con Volunteer Panel

These are just examples; there are plenty of other opportunities for a scholarship recipient to assist in the behind-the-scenes operations of the NSCC Thunder Esports team
