This pathway agreement will allow students enrolled at Northwest State Community College, pursuing an Associate of Applied Science in Agribusiness to complete a Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Education Extension, Agricultural Education with a Teaching License in Agriscience, Or Bachelors of Science in Sustainable Agriculture at Central State University.

While enrolled at Northwest State Community College any student pursuing an Applied Associates of Science in Agribusiness may declare candidacy to pursue a B.S in Agriculture at Central State University. To complete the transfer pathway program, students must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Complete the requirements of an Associates of Applied Science in Agribusiness at Northwest State Community College
- 2. Complete General Education Requirements for Central State University as outlined in this agreement.
- 3. Complete all of the Major Requirements for the Chosen Bachelor's Degree program
- 4. Complete a minimum of 24 semester hours at Central State University.

Any student transferring to Central State University who is pursuing a Bachelor's of Science in Agricultural Education with an Agriscience teaching license, must also meet the entrance requirements of the Education Preparation Program which include:

1. A 3.0 or higher GPA at while attending Central State University.

- Completed 61 Semester Hours of College Courses, Earned an Associate's Degree, OR
 Score the following on the ACT. (Reading ≥ 20, English ≥20, Math ≥21). SAT and Praxis Core Scores will accepted.
- 3. Earn a grade of C or Better in English 1101, English 1102, and Math 1750 (or Hocking College Equivalencies)
- 4. Provide a current and clear FBI/BCI background Check
- 5. Once a student has been admitted to the Education Preparation Program (EPP), Students must demonstrate competency on the Ohio Assessment for Educator Exam in order to pursue the Secondary 7-12, or 4-9 Ohio Teaching License issued by The Ohio Department of Education. Competency on these exams is demonstrated by meeting the state benchmark on the following Assessments:

OAE Pedagogy Assessment

002 Assessment of Professional Knowledge: Middle Childhood (4–9)

OR 003 Assessment of Professional Knowledge: Adolescence to Young Adult (7–12)

As part of the pathway completion, Student will complete related courses to prepare them for the exam. Including EDU 3263, EDU3264, EDU 3265, AGED4100.

OAE Content Assessment

005 Agriscience

As part of the pathway completion, Student will complete related courses to prepare them for the exam. Including, AGB 2300, AGR 3150, AGR3250, AGR1150, AGR1220, AGR2450, AGR2150, and AGED3110. (See Hocking College Equivalent Courses on page 2)

Students transferring any of these related courses through a programmatic agreement, who cannot demonstrate competency on the OAE content assessment, may need to complete additional coursework or test preparation one or more content areas at Central State University until they have earn successful passage of the exams. Students cannot register for **EDU 4491 Student Teaching** without the successful completion of these assessments.

Renewal and review of this agreement:

This agreement will be reviewed, and updated every three years from the signature date.
