Career Technical Credit

If you attended a Career Tech School you may have classes that can apply as CTAG credit on your NSCC transcript. Let your Academic Advisor or the Registrar's Office know to assist with the process.

Examination Credit

AP - if you took an AP course in high school, you may have earned credit based on your scores.

CLEP and DSST - if you took a CLEP or DSST exam you may have earned credit based on your scores.

College Credit Plus

If you took CCP classes at another college, send your official transcript to NSCC and the credits that can be transferred and applied to your current major will be applied.

Transfer Credit

Send your official transcript to NSCC and the credits that can be transferred and applied to your current major will be applied.



Reverse Transfer

If you attended NSCC as a traditional or CCP student and completed 18 or more credit hours, and then transferred to another college before completing your certificate or degree at NSCC, then you can now transfer those credits back to NSCC to earn your certificate or associate's degree.



Prior Learning Credit

Credit can be applied to your NSCC transcript for learning and education you may have received through an employer, trainings, or certifications. The process may include portfolio review, interview, or testing.



Military Credit

Send your official Military
Transcript and MTAGS can be
applied to your transcript at NSCC.



Industry-Recognized Credential

ITAG credit can be applied to your NSCC transcript for specific Industry Recognized Credentials at the State Level.
