

## Admissions

- Submit an **Intent to Participate** to your high school counselor. Homeschool students should submit this form to the Ohio Department of Education. [ohiohighered.org/ccp](http://ohiohighered.org/ccp).  
**Deadline:** April 1
- Complete a **CCP Application for Admission** online at [NorthwestState.edu/apply-now](http://NorthwestState.edu/apply-now) and submit a signed **CCP Consent Form** to your high school counselor. Your application is not complete until we receive your CCP Consent Form.  
**Deadline:** Summer Term: March 1 // Fall Term: April 15 // Spring Term: November 1
- Complete the **ACCUPLACER Assessment or submit your ACT Scores**. You must meet the state qualifying score in at least one area to be eligible for the CCP Program. Minimum qualifying scores are:  
Reading: ACCUPLACER of 80 or ACT of 22, English: ACCUPLACER Writeplacer of 5 or ACT of 18,  
Math: ACCUPLACER College Level Math of 55 or ACT of 22  
**Deadline:** Summer Term: May 1 // Fall Term: June 30 // Spring Term: December 1

## Acceptance

- Complete the **CCP Advising and Orientation Workshop**. You will receive instructions on how to complete this online workshop in your NSCC student email.  
**Deadline:** Summer Term: May 26 // Fall Term: August 13 // Spring Term: January 6
- Complete the **Online Readiness Assessment** if you are planning on registering for an online class.  
**You must pass with at least a 75% before you will be registered for the class.**

## Advising
