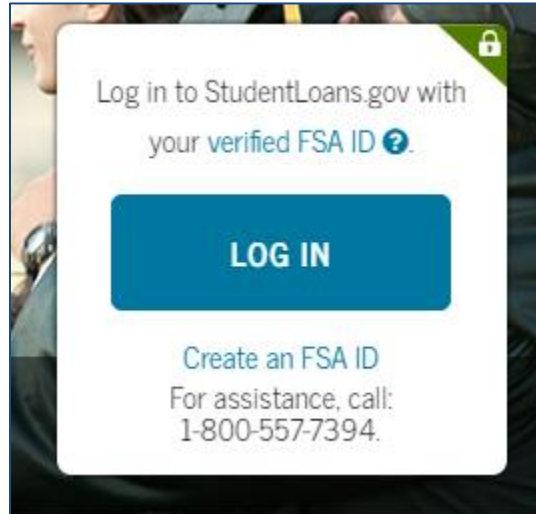



Exit Counseling Directions

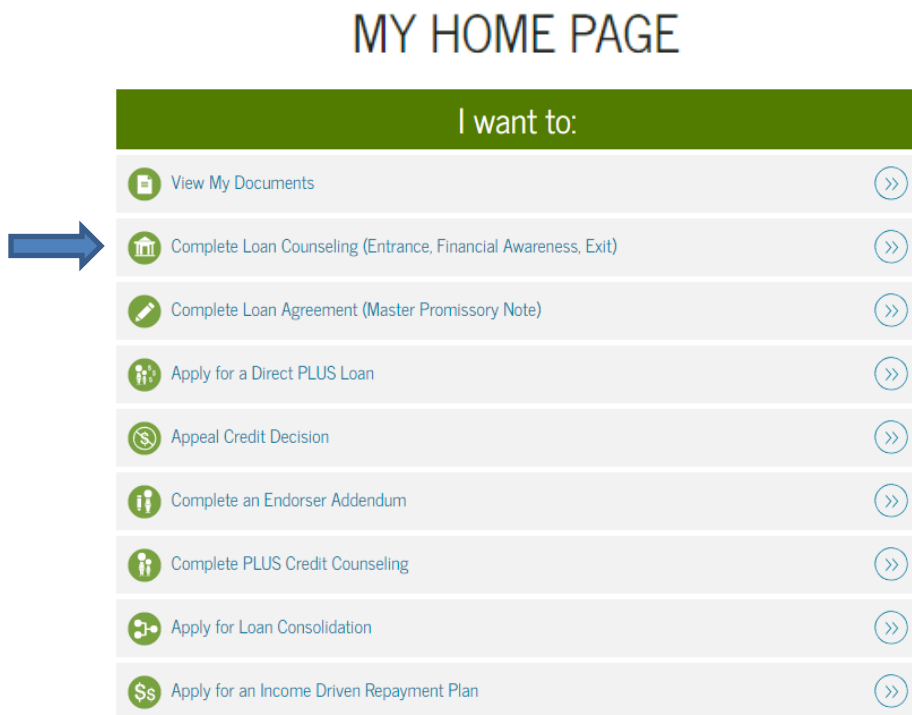
1. Go to <https://studentloans.gov>
2. Click on the 'Log in' box



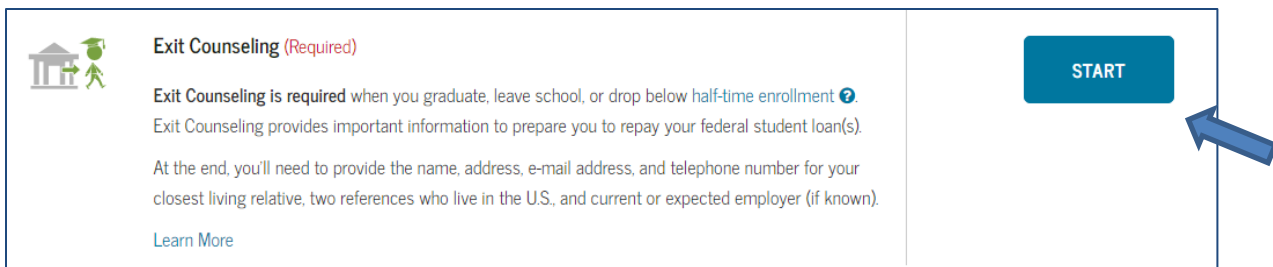
3. Type in your FSA ID Username and FSA ID Password then select 'Log In'. If you do not have an FSA ID, you can create one by selecting "Create an FSA ID".
