



Associate Degree Nursing-RN / Practical Nursing  
Admission Committee Guidelines for High School Applicants

BY APRIL 1, SENIOR YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL:

1. Apply to the college and declare major of PN or RN.
2. Submit an Application to the RN or PN program.
3. Submit to NSCC Admissions office a current high school transcript with first semester grades and a list of current 2<sup>nd</sup> semester senior year courses.
4. Complete course placement test (ACCUPLACER) or submit ACT results (if students have both the higher of two scores will be accepted).
5. Complete PAX National League of Nursing pre admission exam by April test date (for RN applicants only).
6. Admission committee will review all high school applications prior to the end of April.
  - Admission committee will not evaluate any HS applicants until this meeting.
  - High school applicants who have met the nursing admission criteria- PAX pre-admission exam, Algebra, Biology, Chemistry, Keyboarding, Computer and GPA requirements will have priority over students currently completing criteria.
7. Applicants will be notified of status in the nursing program by May 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - ❖ Applications received after the April 1 deadline will be reviewed and considered on a space available basis.
