Courses will transfer to the Bachelor of Business Administration degree. Many other four-year colleges and universities will also accept the courses for transfer credits.

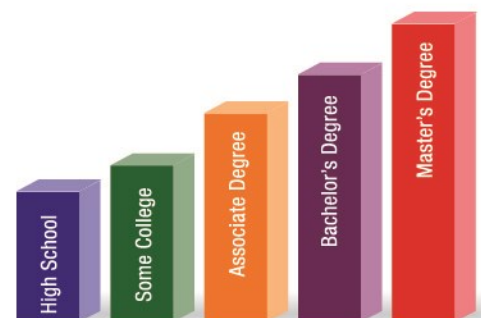
